

Jaymi Wilson (Musical Director)





Director's Notes

Of all Shakespeare's comedies, only A Midsummer Night's Dream has been produced more often than Much Ado About Nothing. Tonight's show is a modern musical, but the plot, characters, and The Bard's typical fifty-shades of humor have all been carefully preserved. We'd like to think that our production will have the same effect on a modern audience that Shakespeare's original script had in his time.

These days, of course, his archaic words and syntax can be hard to follow, so performing a modern-language script with music makes that a lot easier. And while it's true that our modern script features a fair amount of music, it should be noted that Much Ado contained at least five songs in its original form, so maybe we are not too far from the source. Anyway, if you like a night of live theatre and a great classic tale told with music, you've come to the right place; we love putting on "blasts from the past" with a modern twist!







Fun facts about the show!

The title, *Much Ado About Nothing*, is a play on words referencing the secrets and trickery that form the backbone of the play's comedy, intrigue, and plot. Deception is used by many characters, some for ultimately good aims, while others use it to reach evil ends. Central to the play is the contrast between these two motivations – trickery can be good or bad depending on the aim of the character. Another theme takes the form of characters pretending to be others.

It is believed that one of Shakespeare's inspirations was *Novelle* ("Tales") by Matteo Bandello, a sixteenth century work. Stories of lovers deceived into believing each other false were common in northern Italy during the 16th century. A character with views on marriage similar to Benedick appears in *Orlando Furioso*, and another with similarities to the Claudio – Hero plot is Edmund Spenser's *The Faerie Queene*. The witty wooing of Beatrice and Benedick is completely original, and very unusual in style and syncopation to other pieces published during the time.

Pictured below are famous works of Beatrice (Frank Dicksee 1921), Hero (John Wright 1849), and the location of Messina on the island of Sicily.



Messina is the 13th largest city in Italy, and 3rd largest on the island of Sicily. The city was founded under a different name by the Greeks in the 8th century BC. It was eventually conquered by the Carthaginians, and then the Romans in the 2nd century BC. During Shakespeare's time it was an important cultural and economic center, with the first Jesuit College in the world (founded in 1548) and an important trade harbor being located there. The city is widely known for its wine, lemon, orange, and olive production, and reached its zenith during the 17th century when it was under Spanish rule. At that time, it was among the 10 greatest cities in all of Europe.
