

# Director's Notes for Beauty & the Beast

"Tale as old as time
Song as old as rhyme
Beauty and the Beast"

Our tale isn't quite as old as time, but it dates back a long way! It was first published in 1740, and was an oral tradition long before that. Of course the original story varies greatly from the modern musical we present tonight, but at its center, it's the same heart-warming fairy-tale that has been loved for centuries. I guess the predominant theme is the reminder that beauty is found within, but I also enjoy the way the Beast is capable of great change, and love is the reason for his accomplishments. ### **About the Show**

The story of Beauty and the Beast started as an oral tradition, and was first published in 1740 by French novelist Gabrielle-Suzanne Barbot de Villeneuve. The story was over 100 pages long and involved a "stupid" beast who went through more than just a change in appearance. 16 years later, in 1756, French novelist Jeanne-Marie Leprince de Beaumont rewrote and republished the story under the title La Belle et la Bete to reflect social concerns and political changes in France at the time. This version was a tale for the entertainment of juvenile readers and is the most well-known told version. Since then, it has been adapted several times for screen, stage, prose, and television. In October 1992, Disney released the animated story Beauty and the Beast that so many of us are familiar with today, and a live-action remake featuring Emma Watson and Dan Stevens was released in 2017. Today, the remake is the 10th highest-grossing film of all time. On April 18th, 1994, the show premiered on Broadway, and has since been rewritten many times and morphed into the show you're seeing today. There are still many versions of the tale told all around the world, but they all feature a few of the same themes: envy going unrewarded and learning to love what may at first appear a beast.


