

Aaron Rocklyn (Author, Artistic Director)
Aaron's credits as a writer, actor, designer, and directory total over 300 shows. His favorite roles include John Proctor in Crucible, Valmont in Dangerous Liaisons, Benedick in Much Ado, Pirate King in Pirates of Penzance, Oberon and Bottom in A Midsummer Night's Dream, Tommy in Brigadoon, ten characters in Greater Tuna, Max in Lend me a Tenor, Lancelot in Camelot, and the roles of Man of La Mancha, Macbeth, Hamlet, and The Foreigner. Some of his favo-

rite directing credits are *The Trip To Bountiful*, *Keely & Du*, *Romeo & Juliet*, *Foxfire*, and *Eleemosynary*. Other credits include Shakespeare & CO., Fanny Hill, The Phipps, The Ordway, The Carowinds, Houston Hollow, Canada's Wonderlands, Scarborough Fare in Dallas, Pheonix Players, Eden Prairie Arts, Theatre-in the-Round, MN Opera, The Guthrie, and Epcot Center.
